At least 28 credits must be completed before graduation. (2) According to the "Implementation Key Points of the Basic Ability Test for Students of Shih Chien University," students must pass the "Physical Fitness Ability" and the "English and Foreign Language Graduation Ability Indicators" specified by the ETPSSM before graduation. (3) Chinese Foundation Courses: Students must take Chinese (1) and (2) with 2 credits each. (4) English Foundation Courses: Students must take College English (1) (2) (3) (4) in succession and pass the prerequisite courses before taking the next course. (5) The foundational physical education courses, PE (1) and PE (2), are taken during the freshman year, 2 credits each. (6) Students who are admitted as outstanding student athletes must complete at least 8 credits of "Varsity Team—Specialized Sports Training (1)-(4)" in the field of sports and health promotion and are not subject to field restrictions. (7) Special courses include two subjects: The Art of Life and Family Science, with 1 credit each. (8) Self-selected courses of interest are divided into eight disciplines: Humanistic Thinking, Aesthetic Cultivation, Civil Sociology, Global Perspective Study, Natural Science, Smart Digital, Sports and Health Promotion, and Foreign Language Application and Culture. Students must take 5 courses from 4 different disciplines does not apply to students who were admitted into the University via International Student Admission. •Students can start taking courses in the first semester of the freshman year and complete 6 credits before graduation. •Students must take 3 courses from 3 different disciplines with total of 6 credits to graduate. •ETPSSM students are not subjected to take courses in Smart Digital discipline. •The restriction of 3 courses from 3 different disciplines does not apply

Explanation of Program-Specific Graduation Requirements or Other Conditions	 (1) The minimum graduation credits are 128 credits (at least 28 credits for general studies, 63 credits for major required, and 37 credits for electives) (2) For 37 elective credits, minimum 25 credits must be taken from the ETPSSM; other 12 credits can also take from the ETPSSM or any other departments or programs. (3) The 28 credits required by the school must include courses in three fields among the eight optional fields of interest, that is, 6 credits. Before graduation, students in this program must complete the smart digital field course "Programming for Application". (4) The ETPSSM has graduation thresholds. For information on English and Foreign Languages Graduation Ability Indicators, please refer to the English and Foreign Languages Graduation Ability Indicators Implementation Policies.
